Before you come...

Prior to your first Thomley visit, we need you to fill out an enrolment form. This ensures we have all your details for health and safety reasons and can sign you up to our news. You are then able to make a booking. If you need to make a change to your booking, then please let us know as soon as possible.

On the day of your visit...

All set for your first visit? Please make sure you bring sun cream or your wellies (or both!), a packed lunch and of course spare clothes or any medication you may require. When you arrive, ring the buzzer on our gate, where a member of the team will come and let you in. We will sign you in, take your enrolment form and give you a tour of the site.

How much is it going to cost?

As Thomley is a charity, we ask for a voluntary contribution towards your visit. We suggest an £8 donation per disabled child, and £10 for children without a disability. There is no donation for parents or carers. If you would like a half an hour session in our sensory room, we ask for a further donation of £2 per user. Prices on other days such as preschool days, may differ. Please see relevant leaflet.
