Thanks to all of you who joined us over the Christmas period.


joined us over the Christmas holidays.

Thank you, and I look forward to seeing you in 2015.



We have a new Trustee

We recently welcomed Gill Porter-Smith to the board of Trustees. She brings with her a wealth of local business and marketing experience which will be of great benefit to Thomley. In summer 2014, Gill coordinated the Circus Ball Committee which not only raised a whopping £24,000 towards our café, but significantly raised our local profile and encouraged local companies to become more involved.

Café and social centre

We are steadily getting closer to our fundraising target and now have 80% of funding needed to build the café. If all goes to plan, we hope to start the build in October 2015 and move in to the building in late Spring 2016.

The Music Room

Be prepared for change. To make space for the café, we need to move the music room from its current place to a new location under the eaves of an existing barn near the main entrance. Future visitors will be welcomed with the tunes of Thomley's budding musicians.
