A message from our Centre Manager...

2015 has been a great year and we've enjoyed offering you fun activities and workshops which have enabled you to try new things. In 2016 we are going to undertake some exciting changes, including some major developments to the site.

One of our many priorities in 2016 is to start and complete the building of our new Café – building work will commence from the beginning of March and we aim to complete work by the end of September. We are mindful that this will affect the way you use and access Thomley. Some key points I wanted to make you aware of are:

• For a MINIMUM of two months (March to April), the zip wire and climbing wall will be out-of-bounds due to fencing requirements.

- Part of the cycle track will be out of use.
- The main gate and bell will be relocated .

• Onsite parking will be reduced and access parking (i.e. wheelchair friendly) will be moved to directly alongside the fence line closest to the new temporary gate.

• Current music room will be relocated.
