Cafe and Music Box update...

So now that we are finally going to build the café, there's some stuff you need to know! Starting in March, we will hopefully have a shiny new café and social centre by October.

As the new building will be right in the thick of our site, your safety is our first concern. The contractors have been made well aware of our health and safety procedures and the unpredictability of some of our visitors. They will be vigilant in taking every measure to minimise risk. There will be some temporary changes that you need to be aware of:

- Due to the contractor's compound, the car park will be considerably smaller for a few months (with more space during holidays), and you will need to park neatly to make the most efficient use of space and to enable vehicles to turn around. There will be signage to direct vehicles to park i.e. for disabled access, minibuses and coaches.
- There will be signage to a new entry gate, which will be located to the right of the car park. The bell will be located on the new gate.
- The first few weeks may be noisy due to the fact that existing concrete needs to be broken up. We do not anticipate the rest of the build to be too loud!
- The old music portacabin will be moved and replaced with a new Music Box. There is a temporary music room whilst the ramp to the new one is finished, by the imagination room.
- For the first part of the build, the zip wire, rope assault course and climbing wall will be out of action.

We apologise for any inconveniences but it will be worth it in the end!
