

2017 New activities...

As many of you know, we already offer many term time and holiday activities, and we are always looking to offer more where possible.

Well in 2017 we are going to add a few new sessions to our agenda. These include:

- After school opening on a Wednesday, 3pm-6pm for children with and without a disability (once a month).
- After school opening on a Friday, 3pm-6pm for people with a disability only (once a month).
- Camping - due to popular demand, we've added in two extra camping dates for 2017 and we have some on Saturday nights this year rather than Friday.
- Family nights - we will be putting on more events like The Handlebards and our Harvest evening and the planning has begun, so watch this space!
- Adult cooking night, starting in February. Together we will prepare, cook, eat and then tidy up afterwards. Learning skills such as how to lay the table, cooking and cleaning.

When can I have a party?

People with a disability can have a party on any Saturday, any evening (Tuesday-Friday) or on a Sunday (we will open specifically for you).

People without a disability can have a party on any Community Saturday, any evening (Tuesday-Friday) or on a Sunday (we will open specifically for you).

How much does it cost?

As with anything at Thomley, it's a recommended donation: £160 for a Saturday party - £120 for a two hour evening party - Sunday parties vary depending on the length of time required.

What do we get when we have a party at Thomley?

Parties are based on having up to 20 children, squash, tea and coffee is included, use of the whole site for the whole duration of your party, plus you will be given an eating time in our pavilion.

Can we book extras?

Yes you can! We can arrange an art and craft theme, such as pirates, Pokemon, Minecraft - try us! You can also book time in our sensory room, or a workshop such as bubbles, face painting or something sporty.

Do you provide food?

No we don't, however we have some caterers we know well who would be happy to provide you a buffet of some sort if that is helpful.
