giving their Christmas wishes...




Exciting site changes in 2018...

We added a lot to our service last year, including: trampolines, the wheelchair swing, the pavilion, the construction room and lots of new sports & gym equipment. Well this year we want to continue developing, and we will be adding several more exciting features to the site.

A new sensory room...

We are so excited to add a brand new second sensory room to our site. This will be ready to go sometime in March and you can book in as you would for the current room. This means we can take double the amount of bookings, as we know the current one gets booked out so quickly. The new room will be a bit smaller, however all the equipment will be brand new...So exciting!



An accessible additional soft play space for all ages...

We have mentioned previously about changing one of the play-rooms slightly, to offer an alternative soft play area for all ages. Also providing an accessible ball pit, as we are quite aware it can be difficult without hoist access in the current soft play.

We hope to also have this completed in March, but you will see changes from now until then.

We will also be relocating the current games room, to accommodate the other room changes. This may have even happened before your next visit, but we apologise for this being out of use in the meantime.

You will find the new games room between the construction room and the art room, where the doors are now all open and you can roam between all the rooms more easily.
