Who can visit?

We welcome disabled people of all ages, from babies to adults, and their families, carers or friends. We support people at any stage of their diagnostic journey, whatever their additional needs.

We offer regular days for disabled visitors and their families and focus days for pre-school children, adults, schools, respite groups and the wider community when any family can join us to enjoy our facilities.

When can you come?

We are open from 10:00 am to 3:30 pm, Tuesday to Saturday. In the school holidays we open on Mondays, and you can book Thomley on Sundays for private events. We also run an evening youth club for teenagers, cooking club for adults, family nights and after school clubs. We also take bookings for birthday parties and disability events. What facilities do we have?

Our site is spacious and secure, with a huge range of fully-accessible facilities. We are lucky to have some amazing equipment, which includes: soft play, playrooms, construction room, art room, two sensory rooms, a games room, music room. There is also a teenage and adult building which includes a teenage den, mini-gym and cooking area.

Outside we have a fort and slides, climbing wall, wheelchair swing, park, two trampolines, sandpit, football pitch, small golf course, zip wire, cycle track and lots of bikes & trikes. We also have a huge array of professional sports equipment to run a variety of sports workshops.

At lunchtime you can dine in our lovely pavilion and either order from our Cafe menu or bring a packed lunch.

What makes us unique?

Each day our friendly and experienced staff run additional fun activities which cater for all ages and abilities, from sports, to cooking and art. We also hire external workshops such as animals, to offer something different each time you visit.
