Thomley needs your help to build a community of Heroes...

As you know from the media, charities are not at the top of anyone's financial agenda. Times are really tough and likely to become even tougher. Unfortunately Thomley is no exception. In fact, due to our size and specialism, we are sadly more vulnerable than most.

Building on our current activities, our future vision is to extend our work to provide a continuous lifelong learning and transition programme to enhance the overall well-being of each person who visits Thomley. We will continue to provide leisure/recreational activities for all, and additionally develop focused self/life/work skills and purposeful activities in our quieter times. We see this as a natural extension to our current work. To achieve this we are:

- Actively talking with other organisations who can fill in the gaps of our experience.
- Looking at ways to generate income from our assets, e.g. barns, office space etc.

• Use this vision to access new streams of funding that have previously been closed to us.

It costs £500k annually to run our charity and only £60k income is generated through donations by you, our visitors. This leaves a large hole to fill every year, which as you can imagine, is both time consuming, relentless and unsustainable in the long term.

We are sharing our funding challenges with you as we have always believed in working in an open way and actively seeking your help so that Thomley continues to survive now and in the long-term. Here are some ideas on the ways you can help:

- Introduce us in your place of work to become charity of the year.
- Set up a monthly donation scheme with us, £10 a month.

• Introduce us to friends, colleagues and family members who are interested in supporting a local charity.

- Undertake fundraising events on behalf of Thomley.
- Volunteer to support local community fundraising activities.
- Running an eBay trading site.
- Providing expert advice for us on commercial development/trading, fundraising, etc.
- Become a trustee, patron, ambassador.
- Leaving a gift in your will.

Dressing up is optional and there will be a prize for the best car boot and outfit on the evening! To book, email: bookings@thomley.org.uk or call: 01844 338380


Christmas Market 24th November, 10am - 3pm Free entry - No need to book
