Current guidance for December re-opening...



We have worked tirelessly to ensure our site is safe and compliant with Government guidelines ever since we re-opened in July. Please read the below guidance before you visit, which is likely to change by the time we re-open (please see our Facebook page or website for the most up to date version).

You will see on your next visit that there is a QR code at reception when you sign in. This is not optional and all visitors must scan the QR code with their phone before accessing our facilities to support the Government's track and trace system.

We have been keen to open as many of our rooms as soon as safely possible. This does however mean that some rooms will have to remain shut for the time being. From December 3rd, the soft play area and mini gym will remain closed, however we will attempt to open all other indoor areas, including the playrooms, imagination room and construction room. These rooms may have very limited toys in, to help our staff with the strict cleaning measures.

There will be a clearly signed entry and exit door on all rooms and a one-way system throughout most buildings. The pavilion will have limited tables available to eat at and they must be pre-booked at reception. We have also added automatic sanitiser dispensers at the entrance to the cafe, the art room and the playrooms.

We know that change is not ideal for our visitors, but it is also extremely difficult for us to provide the full range of facilities and be compliant with all the guidelines, so we have simply had no choice.
