All young people need guidance to prepare for their future. A young person with special educational needs (SEN) may face additional challenges to achieving their goals.

The ACHIEVE program is aimed at developing those important independent living skills alongside functional skills to enable learners to lead a fulfilling and substantially independent life. Our program is a mixture of blended learning and hands on, practical tasks.

What's involved?

The course is one year long, in term time only and is run over two and a half days per week.

The groups are small, with a maximum of 10 learners. The course is written to be inclusive of individual needs and takes into account the outcomes on a learners EHCP, their own views, individual areas of strength and development and their progression

We work closely with other professionals such as:

- Speech and Language Therapists
- The Autistic Teaching Company
- Local Authority
- SEN Team
- CAMHS
