We look forward to welcoming you back on site in 2025 and will see you all very soon!



## The cost of running Thomley this year and what that means for visitors...

As Thomley continues to develop and provide more for visitors than ever before, expenditure is always increasing. For example our staffing costs, utility bills and stock have all gone up considerably in the last 12 months and will continue to do so in 2025.

Please see the statistics in this info-graphic which summarises the costs to run Thomley in 2025. To help cover these costs we have made our first increases to visitor prices in the last few years. This will see £2 added to the full price and reduced price ticket costs. We have also added £1 per 'Additional adult' that attends with visitors, please note this does not apply to the first parent or any carers that attend with a visitor. The majority of venues charge for parents and they charge considerably higher than this.

For the third year in a row our camping pod (and camping) fees are remaining the same, and we will continue to post special offers throughout the year. Similarly, the sensory fees will remain the same for the third year in a row.

Thomley is a Charity and we rely heavily on our fundraising to cover our running costs every year. We want you to help us ensure Thomley is here providing essential services for people with a disability well into the future.

Lastly, our price of a membership will also stay the same, at £25 (reduced rate) and £30 (full rate) per child.
